

Assembly instructions




HEAD

- 1 Before starting to glue bend the foldings as shown in the graph.

-  Blue foldings to the outside
-  Red foldings to the inside



Its very important to have a good glue, we recommend UHU all-purpose that sticks faster than others. Anyhow every glue needs a moment to stick so the into account that assembly time is about 90 min.





First glue the side tab of the snout, this will help you to visualize where the tabs have to be glued.

Start gluing the inner tabs one by one to the snout, it's better to do it one side first and then repeat the process in the other side.





This graph shows an overview of the tabs that need to be glued to create the Head . These tabs are shaded in gray and have to be attach as the arrows indicate.

JAW

Apply glue in all the grey tabs show in the graph and start at one side and then repeat the process in the other side.









Assemble piece **d** (jaw) separately from the head as shown in the graphic.





Once both pieces are ready you can fix them together by gluing the top tabs of the jaw under the snout and the under tabs of the head into the back jaw. In this graph the tabs are shaded in gray and the arrows show where they have to be attached.




Neck

Fold all the tabs from the side first, then apply glue in all of them. Grab the other side and place it over the the folded tabs, apply pressure to fix it all at once.





∟ This folding and the pinhole are to hang the mask in the wall with a nail or a screw.

To fix the head to the neck start by sliding the under tab of the jaw into the slot in the front of the neck, apply glue from the inside wait until its fixed. Then move to the tab in the top back of the head and slide it in the slot of the top back of the neck, also apply glue form the inside.





ANTLERS


The antlers are the most challenging pieces to assemble. We recommend to start from top to bottom and to glue one tab at the time.


Remember that paper can be folded in both directions so Caution! Make sure the second antler is a mirrored version of the first one, by folding every line in the opposite direction.



Paper can be fold in both directions so be careful and create two different antlers









EARS








The ears have to be assembled separately. Start by sliding the flap towards the inside, and apply glue like its shown in the graph. Caution ! Build each ear mirrored



10 Attaching the antlers

Once the antlers are dry attach them into the two triangular tabs in the top sides of the head by folding the tabs and gluing from the inside.







From the inside you can fix the tab with glue

Repeat the process in the other side

Once the ears are dry insert the bottom part in the notches on the top sides of the head, behind the antlers. Attach them by gluing the tab with a separation angle in the inside.

Now your deer is ready



You can wear it as a Mask



Or you can hang it in the wall. For this option there are 2 folding lines in the back of the neck, you can push them to the inside so you get a flat surface to put against the wall, with a nail or a screw you can hang them using the hole in the back.
